Supplementary Sailing Instructions

1. Schedule of Race

2. Locations

- 2.1. The race office is in the North-eastern corner of the KBSC clubhouse
- 2.2. The official noticeboard is located at on the Northern side of the KBSC club house near the change rooms.
- 2.3. Signals made ashore will be flown on the flagpole on the lawn to the North of the clubhouse.
- 2.4. When the AP flag is shown ashore, the next warning signal will be not less than 20 minutes after the AP flag ashore is removed.

3. Start / Finish Line

- 3.1. The Start line will be between an orange flag on the race committee boat and an orange or red flag on a pin buoy at the port end.
- 3.2. The finish line will be between a blue flag on the race committee boat and an orange or red flag on a pin buoy on the committee boat's port side.

4. Marks

- 4.1. Marks 1, 2 and 3 will be inflatable pink buoys.

5. Penalty System

- 5.1. RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

6. Time limits

- 6.1. For the purpose of time limits, Mark 1 shall mean the first mark for each fleet to be rounded. The Mark 1 time limit shall be 30 minutes.
- 6.2. The race time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish shall be 1 hour.
- 6.3. The Finishing Window Time limit for boats to finish after the first boat sails the course and finishes, is 20 minutes.

7. Class Flag

- 7.1. The class flag will be the International Mirror Class insignia in black on a red background.

8. Courses

- 8.1. The course to be sailed will be identified by numeral pennants no later than the warning signal.
- 8.2. All marks shall be left to Port.

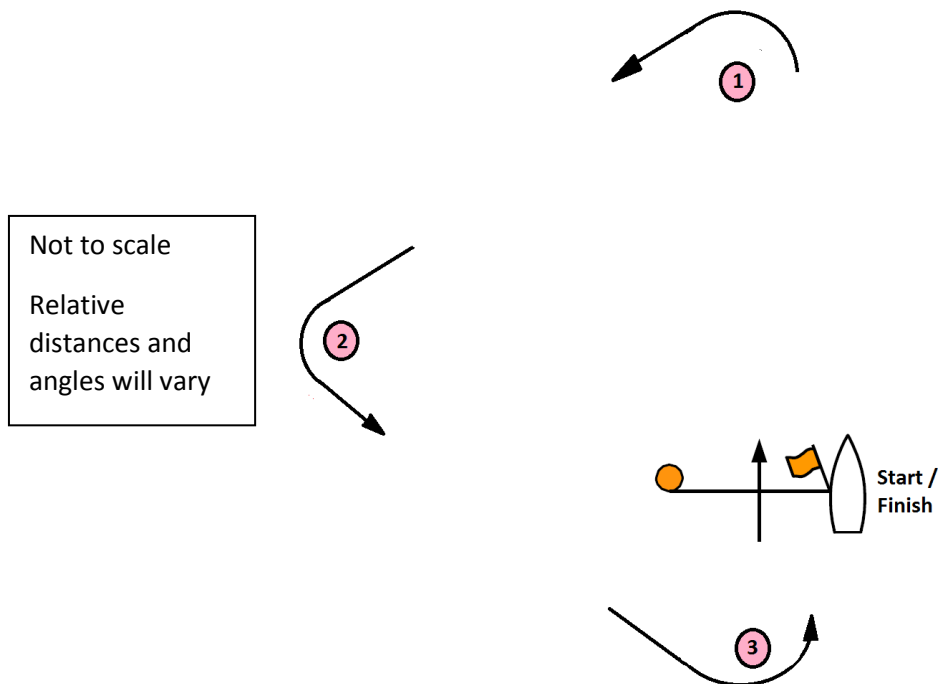

8. Prohibited Sailing

- 8.1. If a vessel > 30m long enters the shipping channel, no boat shall enter the shipping channel. If any boat is already in the shipping channel when such a vessel enters the channel, she must leave the channel by the quickest route possible.
- 8.2. The shipping channel is defined as the area bounded by the entrance to the inner harbour and channel markers A, C, E, F, H, G, D and B as shown in the diagram below.
- 8.3. If an official vessel instructs a boat not to enter the shipping channel or instructs a boat to leave the shipping channel, she must do so immediately.
- 8.4. The penalty for failing to comply with supplementary instruction 8.1 or 8.3 will be disqualification without hearing. This changes RRS Rule 60.2.
