### **Courses - All Fleets**

## **Course 1: Orange Circle**

Start - 4/p - 2/p - 1/p - Arm/s - 8/s - Finish

### **Course 2: Orange Bar**

Start - 4/p - 2/p - 1/p - Arm/p - 4/p - 8/s - Finish

#### **Course 3: Green Circle**

Start - 4/p - 2/p - 1/p - Arm/p - 4/p- 2/p - 8/s - Finish

## Course 4: Green Bar

Start – 3/p – F/p – 2/p - 1/p – Arm/p – 4/p – 2/p – 8/s – Finish

# **Course 5 (shipping movement anticipated):**

#### **Orange Circle with Green Bar**

Start - Arm/p - 2/p - 1/p - Arm/p - 2/p - 1/p - Arm/p - 2/p - 1/p - Arm/p - 2/p - 8/s - Finish

**Shortening Course:** A rescue boat may shorten the course at any mark. Yachts should round the mark, then No.8(s) and Finish. The rescue boat may show a code flag S (Blue square on White flag). There may be an announcement over VHF 72 also.

**Start Line**: shall be an imaginary line between the KBSC race control tower and a day buoy placed outside the outer club Mooring Marker. Boats must pass between the outer Mooring Marker and day buoy in a West to East direction to have started correctly.

Finish Line: is between yellow Mooring Mark and the tower.

Radio Listening Watch: All competing boats should have a listening watch on VHF 72.

**Medical Emergencies:** Should a member of your crew require emergency medical assistance, please call 000 with the condition or acute symptoms and advise them to meet your craft at the Service/Refuelling jetty in Casuarina Harbour (Outer harbour). Advise the operator that both road and helicopter access is available at 33 18.647 South / 115 38.428 East. Also notify the club of any emergency on VHF 72. Bunbury Sea Rescue is also available on VHF 16 for emergencies only.
